Channel your inner-handyman and get to work taking down the old system. There's a good chance that when you remove it, holes will be left after removal. To repair the holes, patch them with spackle. When the spackle is dry, sand down any excess spackle to smooth. Make sure the walls are clean and primed before you paint. **Tip:** *Choose a paint that brightens up the space and is a reflection of your style*.
